WWVP - INFORMATION FOR SPORTS CLUB VOLUNTEERS *WORKING WITH VULNERABLE PEOPLE (BACKGROUND CHECKING) ACT 2011*

The *Working with Vulnerable People (Background Checking) Act 2011* (the Act) commenced in November 2012, with individuals volunteering in 'Activities or Services for Children' requiring registration.

Marist College Canberra requires all coaches, managers, committee members and volunteers working with Marist Sports Clubs, and who are over the age of 16, to register and have valid WWVP registration in order to engage in activities with our students.

Registration is free for volunteers. Cards are valid for 3 years. You are encouraged to submit your form as soon as possible. Processing time will vary but can take up to 4 - 6 weeks.

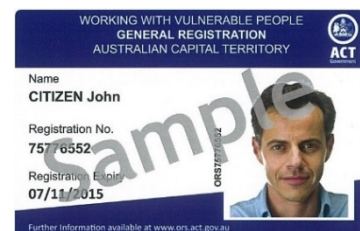
